Limitations

Store and apply between 4 $^{\circ}$ (40 $^{\circ}$ F) and 38 $^{\circ}$ (100 $^{\circ}$ F), protect from freezing until dry.

To resist rain-wash off, allow at least 16 hours drying time above $4 \,^{\circ}$ C (40 $^{\circ}$ F), with a relative humidity of 50 %. Higher humidity at lower temperatures may retard drying.

Always select **TIC 2035/36 Weather Barrier Mastic** for use over polystyrene insulation installed outdoors.

Select TIC 2030/31 Weather Barrier Coating for brush or spray application.

Application

Material Preparation

DO NOT THIN. TIC 2035/36 Weather Barrier Mastic will appear to be thick, but this is a "false" consistency, which "breaks down" readily on application. Stirring is not necessary. Apply only to clean, dry, oil-free surfaces. Keep container closed when not in use.

Application

- 1. Trowel Use clean steel trowel. Apply in full thickness promptly. Avoid excessive trowel.
- **2. Glove** Use a good glove, making strokes as long as possible over the surface. Apply with full glove and spread out evenly. Do not overwork. Multiple coats needed to achieve the minimum dry film thickness.

Clean-up

Use fresh water to clean brushes and equipment before product dries. For remove the dry product use hot soapy water(with ammonia added) or solvents such as chlorinated solvent (non-flammable) or xylene (flammable).
